Obiettivi formativi	The course is designed to prepare students to achieve proficiency in the Italian language at the B2 level, as defined by the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The instructional method adopts an integrated approach that provides learners, from the very first weeks of instruction, with the linguistic structures necessary to communicate immediately in real-life situations. Particular emphasis is placed on communicative functions, which are fostered through engaging and motivating activities focused on the authenticity of contexts, the variety of tasks, and classroom interaction. Grammar is introduced inductively, with dedicated opportunities for systematization, reinforcement, and consolidation of acquired structures. The presentation of grammatical topics follows a modular and non-linear approach. In parallel, students are introduced to aspects of Italian life and culture through a sociolinguistic analysis of various types of texts
